Course overview



Every culture has celebrations and occasions where we give cards. Sending cards to people who are not around us, or giving them to those close to us, is a wonderful way of showing people we are thinking of them. In this course parents and children get hands-on and creative together to make 3D cards to celebrate an event of their choice. Once learnt these skills can be used again and again to create more cards at home. This is a great way to upcycle paper products you may have at home.

Expressing and communicating through the arts can also help build confidence and self esteem in children (and adults).

Absolutely no artistic ability is needed!

What will I study?

You will:

- Choose a cultural event to create a card for
- Use different creative methods to create a 3D card
- Share and discuss with your child each of your creations
- Use creative activities to build bonds and confidence

Assessment method

You will participate in creative activities, discussions, Q&A and receive support from the tutor throughout.
