## Course overview

You don't need a laboratory to do science, science and experiments can be done with things you have in your own home. In this course we will use everyday objects and chemicals to explore science. This course is all about living things. We will use you, things from your local environment, household and kitchen cupboards to have great fun with science and learn a bit of biology with us and at home.

## What will I study?

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You will:

- Do new experiments each week to learn interesting things about yourself, how you work and the living things around you
- Be able to use simple and safe household chemicals to run your own experiments
- Learn how to be safe when experimenting
- Have instructions to take home to experiment further and wow the family

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- Practical and written activities.
