# Wider Family Learning: Glove Puppet Making



### Course overview

This is a 1.5 -hour session for parents and their children where you will use a glove to create a puppet character. These puppets can become characters from books, people, animals, and even characters your child creates. Puppets are a great tool to help your child express themselves. You can go on to create additional puppets at home.

You may want to also attend our follow-on session Story Telling With Puppets session for ideas on how to use your puppets at home with your children. This will provide a fantastic opportunity for children to discover the enjoyment of learning to read in a relaxed environment and to stimulate their imaginations.

### What will I study?

You will:

- Use a glove to create the puppet shape
- Support your child to choose features for the puppet
- Learn to make the puppet move

#### Assessment method

The tutor will observe you making and using a puppet with your child and how your child engages in the activity.

# **Entry requirements**

This session is is more suitable for parents and carers of children of 3 years old and above. We recommend one child per adult to allow for engagement.
