

Wider Family Learning : Story Telling with Puppets

Course overview

This is a 1.5 -hour session for parents and their children where you will be practising a fun technique to bring stories to life. This will provide a fantastic opportunity for children to discover the enjoyment of learning to read in a relaxed environment and to stimulate their imaginations.

What will I study?

You will:

- Use puppets to practise sounds (phonics) and reading
- Discover more about how puppets are used to teach counting
- Use puppets and voice to spark imagination

Assessment method

The tutor will observe you reading and using a puppet with your child and how your child engages in the activity.

Entry requirements

This session is more suitable for parents and carers of children of 3 years old and above. We recommend one child per adult to allow for the reading and activities.

What should I bring with me?

A puppet or the puppet you made in 6721CPS Glove puppet making
