

Wider Family Learning: Museum of Childhood – Trip

Course overview

Come with us and explore the Museum of Childhood. Our tutor will take you through the history of the toys and games in this interactive museum and answer questions you or your child may have. The museum is home to the largest toy collection in the world including chemistry sets, musical instruments, a sensory play area and many hand-made toys.

What will I study?

You and your child will be able to:

- Explore the history of toys
- Interact with the multi-sensory galleries
- Have a go at hands-on-designing in the Design Gallery
- Get hands on with historical toys

Assessment method

You will complete a Scavenger Hunt activity, participate in discussions, and be encouraged to ask questions throughout the session.

Entry requirements

This course is for parents/carers with young children aged 4 and above. You will be responsible for your own children throughout. You will need to make your own way to Bethnal Green Underground station.

What should I bring with me?

Please bring a pen or pencils.

You may want to use your phone to take pictures of your child interacting with history.

There is an eating areas so you may wish to bring a picnic lunch with you for after the visit.

We will meet at 10.20 outside the museum, to enter the museum at 10.30.
