

Family Learning: Create a giant frieze

Course overview

You and your child will be creating a giant frieze on a theme. This is a large piece of art, on paper, which will cover a wall of the college. This will be good for children's group interaction and sociability as well as encouraging them with creativity and production of ideas. Their work will remain on display in the college: good for their self-confidence.

1. Your child draws some pictures on the theme
2. Adds them to the frieze
3. Paints onto the frieze with poster paints
4. There is an opportunity for you to take their photo in front of their finished frieze on (or in front of) the wall where it will be placed

What will I study?

You and your child will be able to develop:

- Listening skills
- Fine motor skills
- Use of colour and shape
- How to come up with an idea on a theme
- How to create as part of a group.

You will learn

- How to encourage your child to ask and answer questions, describe and share their thoughts, ideas and feelings

Assessment method

You will participate in discussions, Q&A, activities and receive verbal encouragement from the tutor throughout the session.

Entry requirements

This course is for parents/carers with young children aged 4 and above. Please wear old clothes.

What should I bring with me?

You will be able to take home your children's sketches and ideas for the frieze. So you may wish to bring an A4 plastic wallet to keep them safe in.
