

# WFL: Creepy Crawley Quest

## Course overview

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This is a 1.5 -hour session for adults and children to have fun together whilst learning. This will provide a fantastic opportunity for children to explore and discover nature. Adults can explore ways of sparking and engaging curiosity and enabling practical skill development in a child.

## What will I study?

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You will:

- Explore plants and animals easily found in nature
- Identify different plants and animals
- Find a range of mini beasts in our local area

## Assessment method

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The tutor will observe you and your child working together, completing your bug hunt and finding answers together.

## Entry requirements

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This session is more suitable for parents and carers of children of 3 years old and above. For this session we strongly recommend one child per adult.
