Course overview

Many of us do not have large gardens. Sometimes we have a small garden or, often just space for a planter on the balcony or by the front door. This doesn't mean that you can not grow anything! In this short course we will explore different fruits, vegetables, flowers and herbs you can grow in a small space.

What will I study?

- Identify what to avoid growing
- Plan what you would like to grow in your small space
