About 10% of the population have dyslexia. During this workshop we will help you develop an understanding of dyslexia, its different forms and how it affects people. You will explore strategies and study skills to help you with learning.

What will I study?

You will:

- discuss the effects of dyslexia
- be introduced to dyslexia assessments
- discuss how assessment results can be used to support learners and help someone study and learn
- identify strategies that support learners with dyslexia and those that don't
- explore resources available to support dyslexic learners

Assessment method

You will participate in Q&A sessions and discussions and receive verbal feedback from the tutor throughout the workshop.

You may be on one of our qualifications courses or have a serious interest in the subject. You will need a good understanding of English.
