

## Enrichment: Enabling Independence

### Course overview

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The course will look at how we can support people with a SEND and those with a physical impairment to become as independent as possible. We will look at how attitudes and the law have changed. The course will help you to build your confidence around supporting independence and communication.

This course is ideal for those in care work, working with students or clients with SEND, studying Health and Social Care or those who work with people with disabilities.

### What will I study?

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You will:

- discuss what independence is
- discuss how communication has helped people with disabilities and ways to communicate effectively
- explore accessible travel and employment
- link independence to British values
- become familiar with charities and support through the ages

### Assessment method

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- You will participate in Q&A sessions and discussions and receive verbal feedback from the tutor throughout the workshop.

### Entry requirements

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You may be on one of our qualifications courses or have a serious interest in the subject. You will need a good understanding of English.
