Course overview

The term SEND (Special Educational Needs & Disability) is a broad term covering 4 key areas of need. In this short course we will cover what those 4 areas are and where specific learning disabilities fit in those categories. We will also look at some common specific learning disabilities.

This workshop is essential for learners on Childcare, Health and Social Care and Teaching Assistant courses and very helpful for those who work in these professions.

What will I study?

You will:

- Become familiar with the 4 different areas of SEND
- Explore your understanding of each of these areas
- Gain a clearer concept of what each area is
- Explore and discuss specific disabilities
- Discuss the range of manifestations of each area

Assessment method

You will participate in discussions and Q&A sessions and receive verbal feedback from the tutor throughout the workshop.

You will need a solid understanding of English.
