CPD: Getting started with Makaton



Course overview

Makaton is based on signs used in British sign Language but it is not a formal sign language. Rather it is an easy way of communicating using signs, symbols and speech. Unlike BSL Makaton signs follow the same grammatical order as spoken English. Makaton is often used by and with people with communication needs or learning disabilities and by those friends, family, support staff and health care professionals.

This course is ideal for those who interact with people with communication needs and very helpful for learners on Childcare, Health and Social Care and Teaching Assistant courses.

What will I study?

You will:

- Discuss how to use Makaton effectively
- Identify and use signs from the core vocabulary
- Be able to communicate simple concepts using Makaton

Assessment method

You will participate in practical activities, discussions and Q&A sessions and receive verbal feedback from the tutor throughout the workshop.
