CPD: Deaf Awareness

Course overview



One in six people in the UK have some form of hearing loss. Some slight, some in one ear and some have profound hearing loss. People with hearing loss often feel excluded when out and about and at work as they struggle to follow and join in conversations. Our deaf awareness course will help you to understand some of the barriers those with hearing loss encounter and improve your communication skills so that our colleagues, friends and family with hearing loss are fully included.

What will I study?

You will:

- Find out how you can become more deaf aware
- Identify ways in which you can be clearer with your communication
- Find out what it is like to live with hearing loss
- Discuss the etiquette of communicating via an interpreter

Assessment method

• You will participate in discussions, reflections, activities and receive verbal feedback from the tutor throughout the session.

There are no specific requirements however you will need a solid understanding of English.
