

LLDD Digital Skills: Looking at Digital Skills

Course overview

This course is the first step to noticing how having a good level of digital skills can help us in our everyday lives. It will explore some of the ways in which computers and other devices are all around us and why.

What will I study?

You will look at some of the key skills needed to be fully involved in the world around you, including listening to others and understanding how to work as part of a team or by yourself. As you do this, you will be shown how and why computers and technology are an important part of life and how you can start to make use of these things to help you. You will also explore issues of safety when using technology.

Assessment method
