

SEND Courses coded A: Digital Skills Starters

Course overview

This learning pathway is the first step in noticing how Digital Skills play a part in our everyday lives. It will explore some of the ways in which computers and other devices are all around us and why. It will move to issues of personal safety and considering the basic functions of computers and devices.

What will I study?

You will look at some of the key skills needed to be fully involved in the world around you, including listening to others and understanding how to work as part of a team, or by yourself. As you do this, you will be shown how and why computers and technology are an important part of life and how you can start to make use of these things to help you. You will also explore issues of safety when using technology.

Assessment method

Your tutor will give you verbal feedback throughout the course. You will also take part in Q&A sessions and discussion to confirm your understanding. There will be classroom activities and role play and you will receive verbal and written feedback.

Entry requirements

You should be able to

- Identify numbers between 0-9
- Identify the letters of the alphabet
- Follow verbal instructions
