

SEND C courses coded Digital Skills EDSQ

Course overview

The SEND C pathway is for learners ready to complete a full Digital Skills qualification. Classes will help you improve your computer skills for the workplace or for your personal life and prepare you to work towards a Digital Skills qualification, at your own pace in a friendly group.

What will I study?

You will start to explore the essential digital skills for life and work at beginners level, so that you will be prepared for the full qualification. This includes the following:

- communicating
- handling information and content
- transacting
- problem solving
- being safe and legal online

Assessment method

You will receive ongoing feedback from your tutor. Work will be assessed by assignment, which are individually graded and may take place both within and outside your class times. All unit assessments are marked by your tutor.

Entry requirements

You may have successfully completed the SEND B2 Digital Skills Beginners course, or an assessment course placing you at this level. Please ensure that your enrolment is by tutor agreement.

What should I bring with me?

You will need to take notes so bring along your preferred tools such as pen/paper or electronic device.
