Course overview



This is the most advanced SEND pathway for Digital Skills. Classes will help you improve your computer skills for the workplace or for your personal life and prepare you to work towards a Digital Skills qualification at Level 1, at your own pace in a friendly group.

What will I study?

You will start to explore the essential digital skills for life and work, so that you will be prepared for the full qualification at Level 1. This includes the following:

- communicating
- handling information and content
- transacting
- problem solving
- being safe and legal online

Assessment method

You will receive ongoing feedback from your tutor. Work will be assessed by assignment, which are individually graded and may take place both within and outside your class times. All unit assessments are marked by your tutor.
