- use maths games and matching activities to develop your skills
- use a calculator to check and solve maths problems

Online and and paper-based assessments, individual work, group work and various maths activities.

No previous qualifications are needed but you should be able to recognise numbers up to 10

You will need to bring a pen, pencil, paper, simple calculator and a folder to each lesson.
