

LLDD English: Developing Skills for Independence Next Steps

Course overview

This course is for people with learning difficulties or disabilities who want to improve their reading, writing and communication skills.

What will I study?

On this course you can learn how to:

- improve your spelling of simple and common words
- read news articles and short stories
- write simple and compound sentences
- use punctuation and paragraph breaks
- write short notes, letters and short reports on a chosen theme or idea
- research topics of interest using IT.

Assessment method

Assessment of individual work, group work, paper-based assessments and communication activities.

Entry requirements

You should be able to:

- recognise some letters
- copy letters
- read and write your own name and address
- recognise days of the week and months of the year
- read a short piece of text
- recognise and write numbers up to 20

You will need to bring a pen, pencil, ruler, paper and a folder to each lesson.
