SEND: Getting Around My local Area



Course overview

Build confidence by sharing ideas with others. In this course you will be able to explore the types of transport used in London and match transport to a journey and plan a trip. You will be able to build communication skills during classroom discussions, make choices, share ideas with people and build personal interests that can be explored outside of College.

What will I study?

You will:

- Briefly look at the history of transport in Barking and Dagenham
- Discuss what type of transport is best for individual journeys and describe your likes and dislikes relating to using transport
- Identify local places people like to visit and where you might like to go
- Discuss what might be needed for a journey
- Plan a local trip

Assessment method

- You will also take part in Q&A sessions and discussion to confirm your understanding.
- There will be classroom activities which you will also receive verbal and written feedback for.
- You will put together a folder of work that will receive written and verbal feedback.

Entry requirements

- Listen & respond to other people within the class, joining in with discussions and activities
- Follow requests and instructions containing 2 key words, signs or symbols
- Make requests independently, for example by vocalising, signing or using symbols, share ideas or preferences
- Indicate an object or person using one or two key words, signs or symbols

An A4 folder, A4 notepad and a pen.
