

SEND: Getting Around For Volunteering And Work

Course overview

When thinking about volunteering or working travel can be a barrier to where you work or volunteer. This course will further build your confidence around traveling safely and cover how traveling for work is different to traveling for pleasure. We will explore locations where you might want to volunteer or work and what your travel options are.

What will I study?

You will:

- Plan a journey when you need to arrive at a set time
- Identify where you may want to work or volunteer
- Find the best travel route for you from home to work
- Discuss what might be needed for a work journey
- Plan a trip to a workplace

Assessment method

- You will also take part in Q&A sessions and discussion to confirm your understanding.
- There will be classroom activities which you will also receive verbal and written feedback for.
- You will put together a folder of work and ideas

Entry requirements

- Listen & respond to other people within the class, joining in with discussions and activities
- Follow requests and instructions containing 2 key words, signs or symbols
- Make requests independently, for example by vocalising, signing or using symbols, share ideas or preferences
- Indicate an object or person using one or two key words, signs or symbols

What should I bring with me?

An A4 folder, A4 notepad and a pen.
