Course overview

Often, we want to volunteer but are unsure where we want to volunteer or do not want to do it on our own. During this course you will explore our wider community and get involved in activities and events that can lead to volunteering in the community.

You will be able to build communication skills during classroom discussions, make choices, share ideas and experiences with people and build personal interests that can be explored outside of College.

What will I study?

You will:

- Build confidence by sharing your thoughts and ideas
- Explore what makes our wider community
- Take part in community events
- Explore how people get to their destinations

Assessment method

- You will also take part in Q&A sessions and discussion to confirm your understanding
- There will be classroom activities which you will also receive verbal and written feedback for
- You will put together a folder of work and ideas

Entry requirements

- Listen & respond to other people within the class, joining in with discussions and activities
- Follow requests and instructions containing 2 key words, signs or symbols
- Make requests independently, for example by vocalising, signing or using symbols, share ideas or preferences

- Indicate an object or person using one or two key words, signs or symbols

What should I bring with me?

An A4 folder, A4 notepad and a pen.
