

SEND Life Skills – Events that changed the world

Course overview

You will look briefly at events throughout history that have helped to make the world the place we live in today. Topics will include the role of individuals and how their ideas helped to make the world a different place to live in. You will be able to build confidence and communication skills during classroom discussions, sharing ideas with others and identifying parts of the changing world around us. You will be able to explore changes in technology and how these changes have continued into the modern world. The effects of each event will also be discussed allowing students to identify the results of on individuals, Nations and peoples.

What will I study?

You will:

- Cover a brief history of famous events including the Armada and the first Undersea communication cable
- Discuss why have some events been forgotten or ignored
- Explore how places have changed over time including names and sizes
- Discuss why are some places named after areas in other countries
- Look for information using books and the internet
- Discuss how different events have affected people and the world

Assessment method

- You will take part in Q&A sessions and discussion to confirm your understanding.
- There will be classroom activities and role play which you will receive verbal and written feedback for.
- You will put together a folder of written work that will receive written and verbal feedback.

Entry requirements

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- Listen & respond to other people within the class
 - Follow requests and instructions containing 2 key words, signs or symbols
 - Join in with discussions and activities
 - Make requests independently, for example by vocalising, signing or using symbols
 - Indicate an object or person using one or two key words, signs or symbols
 - Combine two or three words, signs or symbols
 - Communicate with a familiar person using single concepts, ideas or preferences

What should I bring with me?

An A4 folder, A4 notepad and a pen.
